each square tapered column of well-figured rock crystal, having four sides and a pyramidal top; resting on a lacquered base; good antique condition with no chips or cracks to crystal; some lifting to veneers on bases. Rock crystal is the purest variety of Quartz and is transparent and colorless. Its name derives from the Greek term *krystallos* meaning 'ice' and is the sister gemstone to colorful varieties of quartz, such as amethyst and citrine.
